These solutions, where power quality and reliability are essential, could be grid, off grid or for emergency use.


Could you describe the mission and the mindset of the company?

Juststandout will lead the business efforts of Nigeria to provide energy, specifically efficient and alternative energy, to Nigeria and Africa. Our aim is to bridge and to solve the "Kilowatt Divide". Today Nigeria with an estimated 178M people has an installed capacity of 11,000 MW.

What is the Kilowatt Divide?

Kilowatt Divide is a term I coined a few years ago regarding the energy challenge we face in Nigeria and the rest of the developing world. The Digital Divide has been bridged, now it's time to bridge the kilowatt divide. Grandma in the village can chat or video call her grandchildren anywhere in the world.

As you can see from the chart Nigeria currently has an installed electric capacity of 11,000MW as compared to South Africa that has 47,000MW; a country that is 1/3 of Nigeria's population.



The Kilowatt Divide exists due to the absence of absolute kilowatts and wasted kilowatts, a lack of efficiencies within the distribution system, and the efficiencies of equipment that are being used in residential and commercial structures. We are passionate about bridging the Kilowatt Divide because we believe it is the main key to Nigeria being truly the giant of Africa.

Finally, I believe that Africa is going to leapfrog into the power sector with new technologies in energy storage, efficiencies, smart grids and decentralization.



How does Juststandout contribute to the Sustainable Development Goal number 7 set by the United Nations: Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all?

We are active contributors through advocacy and implementing mini grid projects to increase the number of people with access to energy. We are currently working on a project that would include recycling lithium ion batteries and Schneider Electric products to power primary health care centers. Could you give an example of a recent off-grid project?

Consultation and implementation of a 25.8KW mini- grid Solar Upgrade for Rufkat Danjumu Maternity, Taraba State. The Maternity clinic serves the Takum local government area with a population of 179,900 (2016 est). The project used Schneider Electric inverters, charge controllers, battery monitor, combox and system control monitor.
